



**PASAF NOTICE 2**  
**Information Provided to MNAs/NOCs  
as an Aid in Preparing for  
the 2019 Pan Am Games  
30 April 2019**

**Access to Training prior to the Venue Opening on 29 July 2019**

The following is provided as an aid to MNAs and NOCs in preparing for the Sailing Events in Paracas, Peru, as a part of the 2019 Pan Am Games.

If an athlete or NOC wish to arrive and to sail in the Paracas area prior to 18 July, they must make private arrangements, to the extent that they may be able to do so.

- July 18-22      This is the Delivery Window for Containers to arrive at the Land Venue.
- July 23-26      Access to the Land Venue is strictly PROHITED by NOCs and athletes of all MNAs.
- NOCs may open their containers and remove needed equipment.
  - Once removed from the container, the equipment must leave the Land Venue Site (Yacht Club) and be taken to wherever the NOC has arranged to store the equipment and to sail-out of for training until 29 July 2019.
  - If an NOC has located its sailing and training equipment outside of the land venue, they may sail and train in the planed racing areas on the water.
- July 27-28      Limited Access to the Land Venue for NOCs in order to unpack containers
- Access is limited to 6 persons for the 1<sup>st</sup> Container, and 2 additional persons from the NOC for each additional container.
  - There shall be NO Sailing out of or into the Land Venue on these two days.
- July 29          Land Venue OPENS for all NOCs and Officials
- On the water training out of the Venue may begin
  - Boats and equipment that were at other locations may return to the venue for the Games.
  - Schedule and access governed by NOR and SI's from this date until the end of the 2019 Pan Am Games.
