Facts Found:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. NOR 2.1 limits advertising and applies Olympic Charter rule 50 restrictions which bans advertising on clothing or equipment. 2. Boats are allowed to measure in 4 kites of different sizes. 3. On one of her 4 kites, URU used black ink to cover an advertising logo. The details of the logo were blackened out, but the general shape of the logo remained. 4. The kite was presented to the measurer at measurement with the logo blackened out. 5. URU discussed the alteration with the measurer, who approved the kite. 6. URU raced with the kite and its blackened out logo in race 14.
