Procedural Matters:		
Facts Found:	 On a beat, URU on starboard tack and CUB on port tack were on a collision course, with CUB having about a ¼ BL lead. When about 2 boat lengths away, CUB bore away to pass behind URU. URU luffed to tack to leeward of CUB. After URU completed her tack, CUB luffed to avoid contact.

Conclusions and Rules	 When URU altered course to tack, there was sufficient room that CUB did not have to immediately change course. So URU did not break 16.2. URU completed her tack before CUB had to alter course to avoid contact, so URU did not break 13. No rule was broken.
