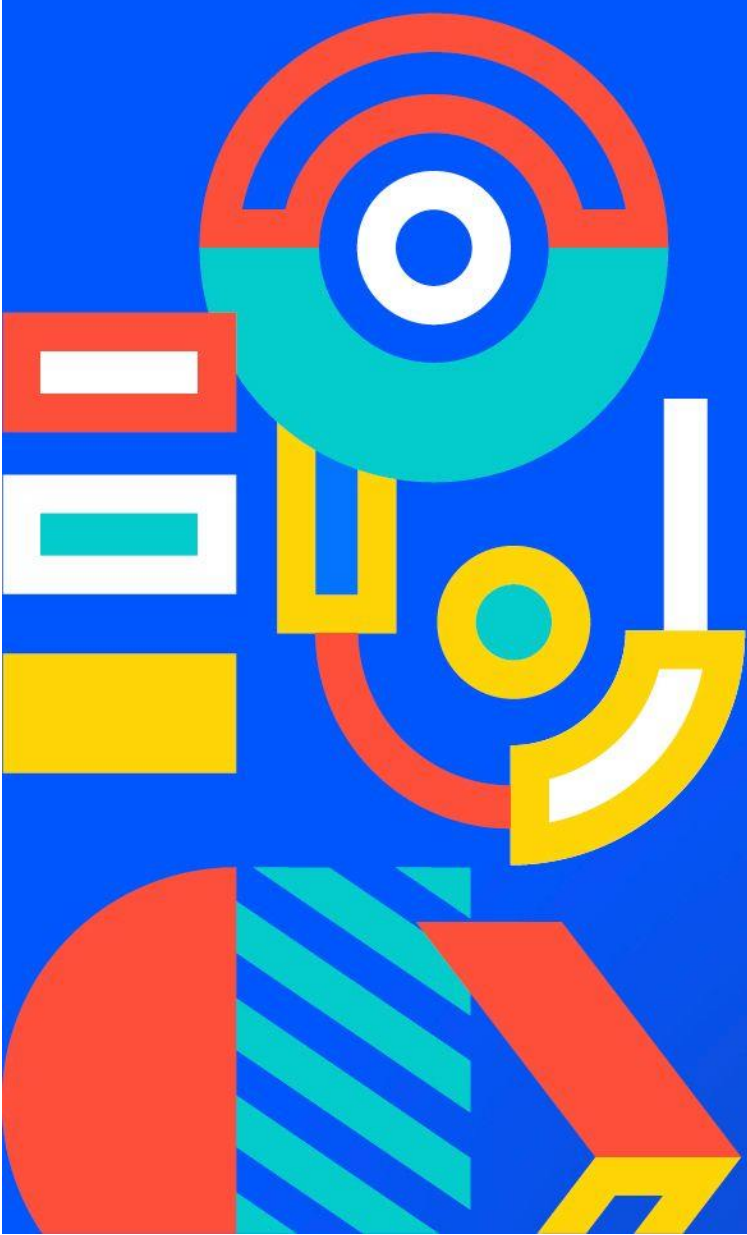

## Entry quotas

The National Olympic Committee (NOC) is the organization in each Pan American country recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) as responsible for Olympic sports in that country. The Member National Authority (MNA) is the organization in each Pan American country recognized by World Sailing as the national governing body for the sport of sailing.

Qualification by NOC – 168 athlete places. A country's National Olympic Committee may enter no more than one boat in each of the 13 Pan American Games sailing events. Qualification procedures and rulings are the responsibility of the Panam Sailing Qualification Committee.

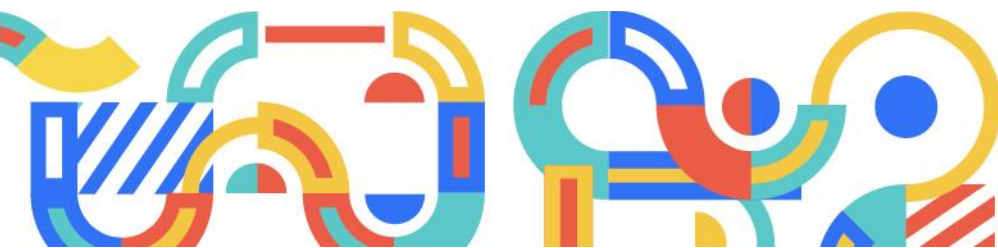
## Cali 2021 quotas

The following athletes are the gold medalists in the 4 events who have qualified directly in the Cali 2021 Junior Pan American Games to the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games:

If the named athletes cannot participate in the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games, the place will be lost. The lost place may not be transferred to the athlete's NOC or to any other athlete.

Athletes who qualified in the Cali 2021 Games are additional to the NOC quota in any event. The NOC is entitled to qualify other places according to the following qualification system in addition to the Cali 2021 qualified athletes. Please note that, Cali 2021 qualified athletes are not eligible to qualify a country place for their NOC since they are already qualified for the Santiago 2023 Games.

### ***Athlete eligibility***

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

All athletes must be at least 15 years old in the year of the Pan American Games. All the athletes shall provide their World Sailing ID number.

An athlete may qualify their NOC for the Santiago 2023 Pan American Games only when eligible to represent that NOC under World Sailing Olympic Qualifying Eligibility rules and Panam Sports regulations. Nationality rules apply to all members of the crew.



An athlete qualified by name in an event (see Cali 2021 quotas section) is not eligible to qualify their NOC for a country place in that event or any other, but a different athlete from the same NOC may do so.

Equipment Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of Equipment Class Associations shall apply.

An athlete who has qualified himself / herself or their NOC in an event may not thereafter qualify another NOC in that event or any other, irrespective of any change in their nationality as defined by Panam Sports, or their ability to claim multiple citizenship.

## **Qualification system**

The host country will automatically qualify one boat place in each of the 13 Pan American sailing events.

The highest placed not yet qualified NOCs in each of the relevant events at designated Qualifying Regattas will qualify one boat place per event according to the quotas presented in the table in Section of Maximum Quota Per Event.

For purposes of NOC qualification in men's and women's events, men and women shall be ranked separately in regattas where men and women race together.

An athlete who has qualified their NOC in any event may not thereafter qualify the NOC in another event.

Competitors intending to qualify a NOC in a SANTIAGO 2023 event designated as MIXED in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event will be required to compete as MIXED in the Qualifying Regatta. The NOR for the Qualifying Regatta shall include an article confirming this requirement.

Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of Class Associations shall apply.

Athletes from a minimum of three countries must compete in the relevant event at a Qualifying Regatta for it to be considered valid.

If a designated Qualifying Regatta is cancelled or fails to meet the requirement for a valid series, the places will be divided among valid regattas for the relevant event(s) in a proportion determined by the Qualification Committee. The Qualification Committee will attempt to maintain continental balance with respect to location in the selection of alternate Qualifying Regattas.



The Notice of Race of a Qualifying Regatta shall be reviewed and approved by Panam Sailing at least four (4) months before the event.

The Notice of Race of a Qualifying Regatta shall specify that:

- a) For purposes of country qualification for the 2023 Pan American Games, the Qualifying System and Regatta Schedule, Sailing - 2023 Pan American Games, Santiago, Chile (Qualifying System), shall apply. See <http://panamsailing.org>
- b) All events designated as qualifiers for the Pan American Games shall conform with the formats specified for those events in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event of the Qualifying System.
- c) Competitors intending to qualify a country in a SANTIAGO 2023 event designated as MIXED in the Section of Maximum Quota Per Event will be required to compete as MIXED in the Qualifying Regatta. In the Lightning Equipment Class this means 1 Man and 2 Women.
- d) A competitor may qualify a country for the 2023 Pan American Games only when eligible to represent that country under IOC and Panam Sports and World Sailing rules and shall provide their valid World Sailing ID number to the organizer.
- e) Class Rules requiring competitors to be members of the relevant Class Associations shall apply.

The Principal Race Officer (PRO) for a Qualifying Regatta shall be certified as a World Sailing International Race Officer (IRO). Requests for replacement of the International Race Officer with a nationally certified Race Officer must be submitted for approval by Panam Sailing at least 30 days prior to the start of the regatta.

The International Measurer who serves as the Equipment Inspector Chief shall chair the Technical Committee for a qualifying Regatta and shall be certified as a World Sailing International Measurer (IM). Requests for replacement of the International Measurer with a nationally certified Measurer must be submitted for approval by Panam Sailing at least 30 days prior to the start of the regatta.

The Protest Committee for a Qualifying Regatta shall be constituted as an International Jury in accordance with Appendix N of the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing. The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions shall specify that the right of appeal is denied, as per RRS 70.5.

The Qualifying Regattas for each event of the 2023 Pan American Games and the number of boat places allocated to each regatta are listed in this document.

Qualifying Regattas shall not be held before April 1, 2022. All Qualifying Regattas shall be completed no later than July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

## UPDATES

Dates and locations of Qualifying Regattas will be updated as appropriate, circulated in revisions of this document, and posted on the PANAM SAILING website.

### ***Confirmation of quota places***

Panam Sailing shall confirm to Panam Sports and NOCs the places qualified by the NOCs no later than July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

NOCs shall confirm to Panam Sports and Panam Sailing the places they will use no later than July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

### ***Allocation of universality quota places***

- NOCs/MNAs shall submit applications for universality quota place(s) no later than July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- Panam Sailing shall confirm the allocation of universality quota places to the NOCs and Panam Sports no later than July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- NOCs shall confirm their intention to use allocated universality quota places to Panam Sports and Panam Sailing no later than July 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
- Universality places will be allocated by the Qualification Committee according to the following criteria:
  - Results of the designated athlete in the Qualification Regattas, in World, Continental and Regional Championships and in Equipment Class Championships.
  - The WS World Rankings (if applicable).
  - Continental balance with respect to NOC representation in the specified event and in the sailing competition overall at the 2023 Pan American Games.

### ***Reallocation of unused quota places***

If necessary, Panam Sailing will reallocate unused quota places no later than July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023, according to the process outlined below.

NOCs that received reallocated quotas shall confirm their intention to use the places to Panam Sports and Panam Sailing no later than July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023.



Unclaimed quota places will be allocated by the Panam Sailing Qualification Committee according to the following criteria:

- Results in the last Qualifying Regatta for that event.
- Results in previous Qualifying Regattas for that event.
- Results in other World, Continental and Regional Championships and Equipment Class Championships
- The WS World Rankings (if applicable).
- Continental balance with respect to NOC representation in the specified event and in the sailing competition overall at the 2023 Pan American Games.

The Qualification Committee may reallocate places from one event to another.

## **Qualification for Paris 2024 Olympic Games**

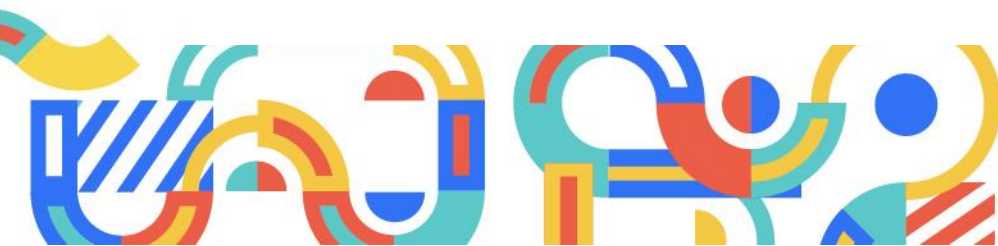
The Santiago 2023 Panam Games shall serve as a Continental Qualifier for all 9 Olympic Sailing events on the Program of Santiago 2023 for the Paris 2024 Olympic Sailing Competition and comply with the World Sailing Qualification System – Games of the XXXIII Olympiad – Paris 2024 [see: <https://paris2024.sailing.org/racing/qualification-system/>]

The Appointed Technical Delegates for Sailing at Paris 2024 are responsible for the implementation of the Paris 2024 Qualification System, and they are the only persons who may provide an interpretation of the System. The following is a summary of the system as of 24 July 2022. The above website link is the only official description of the Qualification System for Paris 2024.

There are two (2) Continents as defined by World Sailing in the Panam Region [see: <https://d3j61mk6mvk9gc.cloudfront.net/sailingparis2024/wp-content/uploads/2022/05/10183058/Sailing-Paris-2024-Qualification-System-World-Sailing-MNAs-by-Continent.pdf>]:

- **North America & Caribbean:** ANT, ARU, BAH, BAR, BER, CAN, CAY, CUB, DOM, GRN, JAM, MEX, PUR, SKN, LCA, VIN, TTO, USA, IVB and ISV
- **Central & South America:** ARG, BIZ, BOL, BRA, CHI, COL, ECU, ESA, GUA, NCA, PAN, PAR, PER, URU, VEN

A valid Qualification Event shall have at least one (1) more unqualified NOC than boat quota places offered, OR, if the entered NOC finished in the top 90% of boats in that Event at the 2023 World Sailing Championships, that NOC is eligible for qualification even if there are insufficient entries from other non-qualified NOCs from their Continent.
